

**LIBERTARIAN U.S. SENATE CANDIDATE
BUCKLEY NOTES EFFORTS OF SENATOR
CHAMBLISS TO MAKE JULY “NATIONAL
WATERMELON MONTH” WHILE MOVIE “IOUSA”
SAYS U.S. HAS UNFUNDED LIABILITIES OF \$53
TRILLION**

Atlanta, Georgia – August 20, 2008

An August 19, 2008 *Wall Street Journal* article by Elizabeth Williamson notes that Senator Saxby Chambliss pushed a resolution to establish July as National Watermelon Month.

Meanwhile, a new movie titled “IOUSA” notes the U.S. has \$53 trillion in unfunded liabilities-about \$461,000 per household. The national debt exceeds \$9.5 trillion. In connection with the Freddie Mac and Fannie Mae bailouts, the debt limit was recently increased to \$10.6 trillion.

Allen Buckley, the Libertarian party’s candidate for U.S. Senate, said the following about the situation: “I like watermelon. However, from farm subsidies to housing bailouts to watermelon month, Saxby Chambliss is a major part of the problem. If elected, I’ll propose legislation to solve the massive financial problems.
